

Table of the Noongar Seasonal Activities

Season	Month	Environment
Bunuru	February, March	Hot easterly winds are up at this time. Noongars moved to the cooler coastal areas where fish and abalone could be caught.
Djeran	April, May	Weather becomes cooler and winds blow from the south-west. Noongars continued to fish during this season. Zamia palm nuts and other seeds were collected.
Makura-	June, July	Winter: The cold and wet weather, along with storms meant Noongars to move inland for shelter. Flowering sheaks signaled that kangaroos were ready for eating.
Djilba	August, September	Rain continues, allowing the bush to regenerate. Eggs from waterfowl were collected.
Kambarang	October, November	Rain decreases at this time, and wildflowers flourish. Quandongs and berries ripen, ready to be picked later in the season.
Birak	December, January	Hot and dry. Paperbarks and Christmas Trees flower during this time. Mullet, marron and crab are ready resources.
